<p>Students learn a variety of choral music in at least three parts. Repertoire is at an intermediate and advance level. Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA to continue eligibility to perform.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">May be repeated for credit.</p>

CHAMBER SINGERS I/IV	REQUIRED () ELECTIVE (X)	CSU (X) UC ()	LAB FEE: None
PREREQUISITES: Previous experience in a choral group. Teacher approval and maintenance of a 2.0+ GPA for eligibility.			
<p>Students learn a variety of choral music in at least four parts. This choir is the main performing choral group. Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA to continue eligibility to perform.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">May be repeated for credit.</p>

PREREQUISITES: None			
Emphasis on performing pantomimes, skits, and scenes from plays. Performance skills emphasized: memorization, blocking, articulation; projection, staying in character.

DRAMA III/IV	REQUIRED () ELECTIVE (X)	CSU (X) UC ()	LAB FEE: None
PREREQUISITES: At least one semester of Beginning Drama and teacher approval			
Students are involved in the productions of a play and its presentation for audiences. Rehearsals occur during class and after school. Must maintain a 2.0 GPA for eligibility.			
May be repeated for credit.

PIANO I/II	REQUIRED () ELECTIVE (X)	CSU (X) UC ()	LAB FEE: None
PREREQUISITES: None			
Students learn beginning and intermediate piano and music theory. Emphasis is on a supervised daily practice in the classroom. Piano provided in class. Students must provide own headphones.

MARCHING BAND I/IV	REQUIRED () ELECTIVE (X)	CSU () UC ()	LAB FEE: *\$125.00
PREREQUISITES: Teacher approval and 2.0 GPA for performance eligibility.			
The members of the marching band perform at all football games, tournaments and community performances. The marching band is the advanced instrumental unit. It is suggested that students also enroll in brass band, woodwind or percussion band.			
May be repeated for credit. Offered in the FALL ONLY.

PREREQUISITES: Audition and 2.0+ GPA for performance eligibility			
The color guard prepares and performs routines with the marching band at football halftimes, competitions, parades, and stage performances. May be repeated for credit.

CONCERT BAND I/IV	REQUIRED () ELECTIVE (X)	CSU (X) UC ()	LAB FEE: None
PREREQUISITES: Teacher approval and 2.0+ GPA for eligibility			
The concert band is the performing ensemble for second semester. The concert band performs at the Holiday Fling, Spring Fling, 2,000 Concert and at Festival competitions. May be repeated for credit.

JAZZ BAND	REQUIRED () ELECTIVE (X)	CSU (X) UC ()	LAB FEE: None
PREREQUISITES: Teacher approval and 2.0+ GPA for eligibility			
Introduction to various types of "stage" music through listening and sight reading. Study of rhythms through playing of various types of music. Basic theory, chord structure, background to improvisation. Play at various group meetings, etc.

PREREQUISITES: Teacher approval and 2.0+ GPA for eligibility			
Classroom activities will concentrate on playing the violin, viola, cello and string bass. Studying different styles of music in addition to notation will be stressed. Performance will be the goal of this class. Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA to be eligible to perform. May be repeated for credit.

PREREQUISITES: Permission of instructor and 2.0+ GPA for performance eligibility.			
This class will review all styles of dance, introduced in Dance Fundamentals. Intermediate level Ballet, Jazz, and Modern routines will be presented. Creative choreography by students will be stressed. Performances and after school rehearsals are required.

PREREQUISITES: Permission of instructor and 2.0+ GPA for performance eligibility			
This class will introduce a new advanced combination of Ballet, Jazz and Modern Dance each semester. The study of choreography will be stressed. Dance ideas from famous choreographers will be studied and used in dances created for performance. After-school rehearsals, and performances are required. May be repeated for credit.
